

2022 Prom Guidelines

In order to provide a memorable and safe night for all prom participants, we will follow the following guidelines:

1. Prom is a school-sponsored event; all school rules are in effect for MCHS students.
2. MCHS Junior and Senior students in good standing are eligible.
3. All MCHS students that wish to attend must register online through the MCHS web-store.
4. Registration is March 15th- April 6th, 2022
5. Prom registration is non-transferable and non-refundable.
6. All MCHS students will need to bring their student ID
7. Please be advised that, while masks are now optional, there may be some exhibits that require a mask to enter due to the nature of exhibit and the limitation in being able to socially distance from other Prom attendees.
8. Students attending Prom will NOT be required to wear masks or show proof of vaccination
9. All Outside Guests will need to provide a copy of valid picture ID (license, passport, state ID) along with completing the Outside Guest Form. Outside Guest forms, with a copy of the ID must be submitted to the Activities Office no later than Friday, April 8th.
10. Students who choose to participate in inappropriate behaviors, including inappropriate dancing, touching or overt displays of affection, will be given a warning and/or guardians will be called to pick up their student.
11. Students are required to wear shoes at all times.
12. Students are not allowed to bring backpacks.
13. Student items are subject to be searched at check-in and throughout the night.
14. The consumption and/or possession of alcohol, tobacco, or drugs before, during, or after the dance are prohibited. Students suspected of violating this policy may be searched or required to take a Breathalyzer test and Minooka police will be called.
15. MCHS invokes a "Good Night" Policy for school held events. Once a student leaves for the night, they will not be allowed to re-enter the school or event.
